There will be negative marking of 0.50 marks for each wrong answer. Candidates are, therefore, advised to keep this in mind while answering the questions.

The computer based / MCQ Sheet examination will be conducted in English and Hindi only.

**General Knowledge/ Current Affairs:** Question in this component will be aimed at testing the candidate's general awareness. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of every day 12

observations and experience in their scientific aspect as may be expected of any educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Indian Economy, General Polity, Indian Constitution, Scientific Research etc. These Questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

**Reasoning:** Analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns will be tested through questions principally of non-verbal type. This component may include questions on analogies, similarities and differences, spatial visualization, spatial orientation, visual memory, discrimination, observations, relationship concepts, arithmetical reasons and figural classification, arithmetic number series, non-verbal series, coding and decoding etc.

**Numerical Ability:** This part will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems, Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between Numbers, Fundamental Arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion, Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, Menstruation, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work, etc.

Computer Fundamentals, MS Excel, MS Word, Communication, Internet, and Web Browsers etc: Elements of Word Processing (Word Processing Basics, Openingand closing Documents, Text Creation, Fortnatting the Text and its presentation features). MS Excel (Elements of Spread Sheet, Editing of Cells, Function and Formulas), Communication (Basics of E-mail, Sending/receiving of Emails and its related functions). Internet, WWW and Web Browsers (Internet, Services on Internet, URL, HTTP, FTP, Web sites, Blogs, Web Browsing Software, Search Engines, Chat, Video conferencing, e-Banking).

In addition to the Admission Certificate, it is mandatory to carry at least two passport size recent color photographs, Original valid Photo-ID proof having the Date of Birth as printed on the Admission Certificate,

### METHOD OF SELECTION

1. The ICECT selection process for the year 2023 will be carried out in multiple stages. Theselection process for ICECT 2023 will be carried out by the ICECT. But, in order to be eligible for the 2023 selection process for ICECT, the candidates have to register and qualify the ICECT 2023 exam with the minimum desirable qualifying marks. The ICECT 2023 selection process will be initiated after the conduct of the ICECT 2023 examination. Eligible candidates from the second Skill Test & Interview & documents verification of the ICECT exam will be qualified to take part in the ICECT selection process for the year 2023.

The ICECT will prepare a merit list on the basis of the performance of the test-takers in the second Skill Test & Interview & Documents verification of the ICECT examination and as per the merit list, thecandidates will be invited to take part in the ICECT 2023 selection process. In order to be selected for the Documents verification of the ICECT 2023 examination, the candidates have to clear the first exam with the minimum desired marks, which will be prescribed bythe ICECT commission. The ICECT commission may or may not introduce an additional round of exam as per the requirement.

- The qualified candidates have to appear for a document verification process in which they have to submit all their original documents
- The candidates also have to submit their Department and Post options during the verification of documents
- While attending the document verification process, the candidates have to carry an original photo identity proof and two recent passport-sized photographs. The photo ID proof can be either of the following:
- 1. Voter ID card
- 2. Aadhar card
- 3. Passport
- 4. PAN card
- 5. College/School Id card
- 6. Driver's License
- 7. Employer Id (for candidates already employed in Private/PSU/Govt sectors)
- Documents that the candidates have to mandatorily submit are as follows:
- 1. Class Xth certificate
- 2. Class XIIth certificate
- 3. In case of an equivalent qualification, the candidates have to produce a letter/orderfrom the competent authority supporting the claim of educational qualification made by the candidates
- 4. Certificate proclaiming the category/caste of the candidates
- 5. Certificate supporting the claim of physically disabled (for PwD category candidates)
